# What can the Learner Support Fund help with?

The fund can help towards the costs listed below. You may need to make a contribution towards these costs. For successful applicants aged 19 years and over, help is available towards:

- The cost of transport if you live more than 3 miles
- ill health.
- Course-related costs these are determined by your course tutor
- Childcare costs for students aged 20+ this is limited to term

To Qualify for Residential support your course must fall into the following categories:

- More than 30 miles from your home or more than a 2 hour return journey
- Must not be available at your local College
- You must be studying a Full Time course
- It must be a Learner Responsive course (your learning provider
- Students who start late will receive pro-rata payments.
